



Level 2 Apprenticeship in Warehousing & Storage

Objective

This Apprenticeship programme is designed for Warehouse Operators working as part of a team to load and unload vehicles, responsible for correct selection and packing of customer orders, ensuring they are ready for dispatch on time.

The Apprenticeship

The Apprenticeship is made up of the following elements:

- Induction and introduction
- Assessment of current on-the-job skills (covers the Certificate in Warehouse and Storage Level 2)
- Functional Skills embedded into the NVQ (Application of Number L1, Communication L1)
- Level 2 Award in Employees Rights and Responsibilities (ERR)
- Level 2 Award in Personal Learning and Thinking Skills (PLTS)

All training and assessment will be completed on site. Your Assessor will tailor the programme for any individual needs.

Timescale

The Apprenticeship is delivered over a 12 month period at dates and times to suit the employer. Each apprentice should expect to commit work time during this period.
