This Apprenticeship is designed for operators who set and operate machines during production, plan and set up the sequence of operations according to drawings, layouts and other instructions.

The Apprenticeship

The Apprenticeship is made up of the following elements:

- Induction and introduction.
- Assessment of current on the job skills (covers the PMO NVQ Level 2).
- Technical Certificate in Environmental Awareness workbook.
- Functional Skills embedded into the NVQ (Application of Number L1, Communication L1).
- Level 2 Award in Employees Rights and Responsibilities (ERR).
- Level 2 Award in Personal Learning and Thinking Skills (PLTS).

All training and assessment will be completed on site. Your Assessor will tailor the programme for any individual needs.

Timescale

The Apprenticeship will be delivered over a 12 month period at dates and times to suit the employer. Each apprentice should expect to commit work time during this period.
