



## Level 2 NVQ Diploma In Mechanical Manufacturing Engineering (QCF)

### Objective

The programme is designed to give those individuals working in a mechanical manufacturing environment the ability to organise work and identify problems.

### The Programme

The programme is aimed at individuals working in a mechanical manufacturing engineering environment who want to:

- Gain a qualification to recognise competence
- Embark on a career change and learn new skills

### Timescale

Although there is no specific timescale involved it would usually take approximately 6 months to complete the qualification.

- Production Assembly
- Composite Manufacturing
- Optical Engineering

Each pathway will consist of 3 mandatory units plus one optional unit from a selection.
