



SMED Training Course

Overview

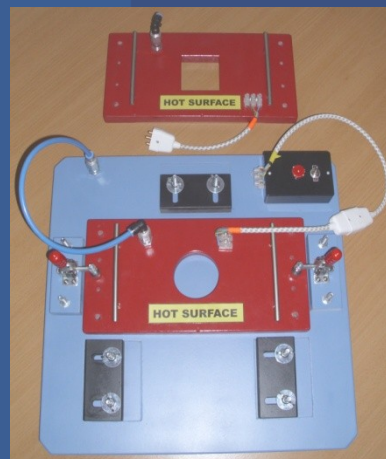
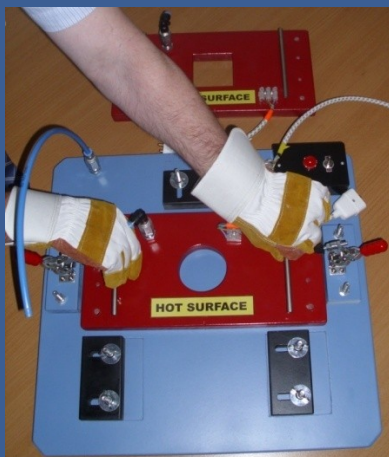
The first day of the programme is training and is delivered on site with a mixture of SMED theory and practical. A focus is placed on the learners to work as a team to apply what they have learned in a simulated environment. Learners identify waste, use structured problem solving, develop action plans and standardised work.

The second day is optional but can be used to analyse a 'Real' changeover which has been recorded the day before. The learners will then develop an action plan to take forward.

Training content

SMED theory and brief history:

- Internal and External Activities
- 4 step approach to reducing changeover time
- PDCA Cycle
- 8 Wastes
- Problem Solving and Action Planning
- Standardisation



Duration

The training can be delivered over 1 or 2 days and can be tailored to suit specific company requirements.
