



TAQA- Assessor Award

Objective

The assessor programme is designed to offer potential assessors the qualifications required to assess in industry. Learners will increase their knowledge and understanding of the assessment process.

The Qualification

The qualification is made up of 3 units.

- Unit 1 Understanding the principles and practice of assessment.
- Unit 2 Assess occupational competence in the work environment.
- Unit 3 Assess vocational skills, knowledge and understanding.

There are two options available: the Award and the Certificate, both at Level 3. The Award requires achievement of units 1 and 2 or 1 and 3. The Certificate requires the achievement of all three units. The qualification is awarded by EAL (Excellence in Achievement and Learning).

Our Approach

The candidate assessor will be given two learners to assess from a TACS Ltd cohort of learners currently being assessed for an NVQ (QCF). Each candidate assessor will be assigned their own assessor and internal verifier. All assessment activity will be carried out in a workplace environment. All knowledge requirements will be assessed using written answers to underpinning knowledge questions.

Delivery schedule

The timescales required are dependent on the assessor candidates' availability to carry out assessments in the workplace.
